LCT 570-G. R. Hickie & Mancl. Flotilla 12, Div. 72, Scheduled for Dog Red White at H+180-215.

LCT 571-R. L. Levin & Murr. Flotilla 12, Div. 72, Flotilla Commander, LCDR Leide, on board on for assault, Scheduled for Dog White at H+225.

LCT 572-J. W. Voight and Knight. Sunk, Scheduled for Dog White at H+225

LCT 573-A. A. Rusche and E. J. Lazear, Flotilla 12, Div. 72, Scheduled for Dog Red at H+225

LCT 586-Joe Carey & W. E. Kushman, Flotilla 12, Div 69, Carried DD tanks onto Dog Green. Second assignment to land vehicles and personnel from APA#4 at H+180-215 at Easy Green.

LCT 587-A. M. Demao & E. D. Bradley. Flotilla 12, Div. 69, Carried DD tanks onto Dog Green. Second assignment to land vehicles and personnel from APA4 at H+180-215 at Dog Green.

LCT 588-W. C. Cook and John P. Harrington. Flotilla 12, Div 69. Carried DD tanks onto Dog White. Second assignment to land vehicles and personnel from APA #3 at H+180-215 at Dog White.

LCT 589-Earl J. Dinsmore & W. R. Hultgren. Flotilla 12, Div. 69. Carried DD tanks onto Dog Green. Second assignment to land and personnel from LSI(L) #2 to land on Dog Red at H+189-215.

LCT 590-R. B. Gilfert and Anderson. Flotilla 12, Div 69. Carried DD tanks onto Dog White. Reported hit by 88s, three crewmembers killed. LCT 536 substituted for the 590s second assignment to land personnel from APA #3 on Dog Red at H+180.

LCT 591-G. W. Novotny and Krieger. Flotilla 12, Div. 69. Carried DD tanks onto Dog White. Second assignment to land vehicles and personnel from APA #3 on Dog White at H+180-215.

LCT 612-William C Smith & William A. Burch, Flotilla 12. Took three direct hits knocking out all engines with one shell exploding in the galley. One man was injured. The LCT 613 towed it to safety, later reported sunk Had been scheduled for H+60 to carry 112th Engineering Bn. to Dog Red beach. *From action report filed 29 June 1944 by Commander, Flotillas 12 7 36.*

LCT 613-Dick Zeldin & Frank Burns. Elmer Muth, crew member. Flotilla 12, Div. 68. Scheduled for H+60 to carry 112th Engineering Bn. Towed heavily damaged 612 from beach to safety.

LCT 614-Donald E Irwin and George A. Pillmore. Luther Carter, GM. Flotilla 12, Div. 68. Scheduled for H+60 to carry 112th Engineering Bn.

LCT 615-Frank Rapoport & R. L. Levine, also Larry Bartlett. Flotilla 12, Div 68. Carried AT CO 116th Infantry into Dog Red at H+120.

LCT 616-A. T. Evans and & Giaimo--Flotilla 17, Div 97, Scheduled to carry 467th AAAW Bn into Dog Red at H+120.

LCT 617-G. R. Keuler & Greathouse--Flotilla 17, Div 97. Assignment to land vehicles and personnel from APA #3 on Dog Red at H+180-215.

LCT 622-J. O. Ponder & W. H. Nordstrom. (Ens Gross?), Flotilla 12. Dog Green at H+60 with 121st Engineering Bn. Hit by 88s. OinC returned to UK suffering from shock. Took half of 615 crew aboard. *From action report filed 29 June, 1944 by Commander, Flotillas 12 & 26.*

LCT 655-G. S. Hobb -Flot 26-Dog Green Beach at H+330 carrying Army supplies. Reported sunk.

LCT 656-F. F Allen and Ens. Peters--Flotilla 26-Dog Green Beach at H+330 carrying Army supplies. Reported sunk.

LCT 703-O. R. Elsaesser and H. H. Huff. Scheduled for Dog Green at H+60 to take in 121st Engineering BN. Damaged by mines, sunk in shallow water and hit by gunfire setting it ablaze. Ens. Elsaesser and half the crew taken aboard LCT 536. *From action report filed 29 June, 1944 by Commander, Flotillas 12 & 26.*

LCT 704-J. W. Robertson & Gross. Flotilla 17, Div 97. Dog Green Beach, H+60, 121st Engineering Bn

LCT 705-G. A. Kappus & R. M. Bleike--Flotilla 17, Div. 97.

LCT 713-F. S. White & H. J. McGinnis, Flotilla 26. Carried DD tanks onto Dog White. Beached under heavy 88mm fire, damaged engines. Three crewmen killed, three wounded. Managed to retract from beach by anchor winch. Towed to UK by an LST.

LCT 714-R. A. Ellis and Palermo. Flotilla 26. Hit by mines, sunk by salvage tug. Scheduled for Dog Green at H+180.

LCT 767-J. W. Wray and Phelps-Flotilla 26, Div. 151. Scheduled for Dog Green at H+180. Damaged, holed in Engine room.

LCT 775-Vincent J. Brangan & J. H. Flad--Flotilla 12, Div 97.
